RULES CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE OF THE STUDENTS

I. BEHAVIOUR

- 1. Students are expected to attend the College neatly dressed maintaining decorum by wearing sarees or in traditional salwar kameez. They shall not come to the College in any other dress.
- 2. Students should wear their I.D. cards every day. I.D. Card should be produced when demanded.
- 3. Any requisition or letter written by the students to the Principal should be sent through the HOD / Class Tutor.
- 4. Students should not sit on the parapet walls or on the steps or staircases.
- 5. Students are not permitted to take their lunch in the class rooms.
- 6. Students should maintain the campus ECO-Friendly.
- 7. Students are forbidden from writting, scribbling or painting on the walls, desk, etc.
- 8. Students found guilty of damaging, destroying College property will have to replace the same at their own cost.
- 9. Ragging is an offence. Any student found guilty of ragging will be dismissed from the College.
- 10. Students found guilty of using foul language or behaving rudely will be expelled from the College.
- 11. Students should refrain from participating in political or communal activities.
- 12. Students must identify those who cause damage to the College property and report the same to the PRINCIPAL.

II. ATTENDANCE

The guidelines of attendance requirement issued by the Periyar University are adopted by the College. Attendance shall be considered semester wise (not annually). A candidate will be permitted to appear for the Comprehensive Examinations in any semester if.

- 1. She secures not less than 75% of attendance in the total number of working days during the semester.
- 2. Her progress has been satisfactory.
- 3. Her conduct has been satisfactory.

- 4. In case the students having 65% to 74% of attendance, she should pay the condonation and allowed to write the university examination.
- 5. If the students are having 55% to 64% of attendance, she should pay the condonation but will not be allowed to write the university examination.

If the students are having below 55% of attendance, she will not be allowed to write the university examination.

III. LIBRARY RULES

- 1. The library will be kept open between 9.00 am & 6.00 pm. on all working days.
- 2. Silence should be strictly maintained in the library.
- 3. Books will be issued to the students on producing their identity cards.
- 4. On receipt of the book, the students should examine the book and report at once the damage, if any, seen in the book.
- 5. Students are prohibited from underlining or writing in the books.

IV. HOSTEL RULES:

- 1. Study hour after 8.30 pm will be strictly enforced in the hostel.
- 2. Students who are found guilty of foul language or rude behavior or assault or at-tempt to assault the Hostel staff will be expelled from the hostel forthwith.
- 3. Sticking of pictures or writing on the walls, windows and doors of the hostel are strictly prohibited.
- 4. Mess dues are to be paid every month before the last date for payment.

Fees: Students can pay the semester fee in three installments.
